Will of A. C. Richardson  
New Hill, NC  
28 May 1901

I A.C. Richardson being of sound mind and knowing the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do make this my last will and testament to wit:

1<sup>st</sup> I will that all my just and hones debts and burial expenses by paid.

2<sup>nd</sup> I will that the division that I made in my real estate heretofore to stand as conveyed.

3<sup>rd</sup> I will that all my real estate and personal property be equal divided between my four children namely: Ardelia Harrington, Thomas W. Richardson, James D. Richardson, and Lulia Richardson.

4<sup>th</sup> I will to my Grand Daughter Imaland [Ima Land] Johnson One dollar.

6<sup>th</sup> I make my son James D. Richardson the executor of this my last will and testament.
