THIS DEED, Made this 30th day of March 1902, by M. H. Harbour of Surry County and State of North Carolina of the first part, to G. P. Harbour of Surry County and State of North Carolina of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said M. H. Harbour in consideration of One Dollar, to G. P. Harbour paid by G. P. Harbour the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey to said G. P. Harbour & North Carolina heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land in Surry County, State of North Carolina

adjoining the lands of M. H. Harbour and others, bounded as follows, viz: Beginning on a rock near your yard 7-0000 North 112 Ch to a rock thence west 112 Ch to a rock thence South 112 Ch to a rock thence East 112 Ch to the beginning containing 1/8 of an acre This lot of land is for a grave yard for the Harbour family The graveyard lot mentioned above is about 100 yards south of the house in which I now live

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforesaid tract or parcel of land, and all privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said G. P. Harbour his heirs and assigns, to only use and behoof forever.

And the said M. H. Harbour for himself and his heirs, executors and administrators covenant with said G. P. Harbour his heirs and assigns, that he is seized of said premises in fee and has full right to convey in fee simple; that the same are free and clear from all encumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the said title to the same against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
